Baby Bottle Update

The De Smet Teens 4 Life group and its fundraising activities really had its origins when I was in high school. It was then that my dad took me to a Right to Life meeting in a near-by town. The interesting thing is that although he was conservative minded and involved politically, he never became involved in any pro-life groups or work that I am aware of. But I did! It sparked my passion for the unborn. It was God's call for me to be involved in the pro-life movement and I have been active ever since my highschool days.



DeSmet Teens 4 Life

At some point God put it on my heart that the key to saving babies was to grow a pro-life generation. That meant educating teens. Having six children of my own, some of which were then teenagers, I set out to organize a group of pro-life teens. The De Smet Teens 4 Life has been active for almost 20 years now. Since kids like hands-on activities, the group focused on "doing things". When we heard about the Plus One Guidance Center starting up in Huron we were eager to support it! We had heard about a fundraiser called the "Baby Bottle Fundraiser" and found that it was well suited for our teens. Each year we visit with some local church pastors about having the teens hand out baby bottles. A certain Sunday is designated for handing out the bottles. We advertise in the church bulletins, put up posters, leave baskets with extra bottles at the church entrances, and share about the center the day we distribute them. We allow 4-6 weeks and then ask that the bottles be returned.

Each of the three years the teens fundraised for the Plus One Center we raised from \$1200-1600. We were amazed! This year, two more local churches were involved in the Baby Bottle Fundraiser, and one in Iroquois, bringing the total to six. The teens love counting the change and seeing the fruit of their work. I believe God has truly blessed our efforts, because they are all for His glory.
